Dear Parents & Students,

Camp South is right around the corner! This year's theme is "Fear Not!" The Bible studies and devotions will help students understand that with the Lord by their side in life, there is nothing they need to fear.

The notes below should help you be fully prepared for Camp South. Please read it carefully! If you have questions, don't hesitate to contact me.

Camp Check-in

On the schedule, you'll notice that check-in begins at 4:30PM and ends at 6:30PM. This generous time-frame is provided especially to help new campers and parents become familiar with the building and grounds at the Unicoi Lodge and comfortable with the Camp South schedule before they say good-bye for the week. Students who do not need much time to acclimate should plan to arrive in the later part of check-in time. If parents/guardians choose to leave the Lodge before dinner, their child must remain in their room until dinner is served in the restaurant at 6:30PM. No student should be found roaming the Lodge without parent or guardian supervision before dinner. Parents are also welcome to stay for dinner, but will need to pay for their own meal. After dinner, students should go to the Master Hall for opening devotion. ***Counselors do not assume supervision of the students until the devotion begins at 7:30PM.***

Phone Calls

Students are welcome to bring a cell phone to camp with parental permission, but the phone must remain in their room at all times. Pay phones are also available in the Lodge for students to use. Students are asked **not** to use the phones in the rooms due to problems in the past. If you need to get a hold of your child for emergency reasons, please call Mr. Bitter at 904-864-3384.

Medications

If students are bringing any kind of medication, prescription or non-prescription, they need to give it to their counselor for safe keeping. Medications can be turned in at "Reflection Time" on Monday. Students will need to go to their counselor to take their medications. Campers are asked to only keep inhalers and epi-pens in their possession. This is done for the safety of all the students.
