Here We Stand Rally - FAQS

COST

\$260 per person between January 15 - March 16, 2017.

\$295 per person between March 17- May 16, 2017.

REFUNDS

Full refunds will be given for cancellations prior to May 16, 2017 (the rally registration deadline). On or after May 16, refunds will be allowed (less \$100 cancellation fee) only for the following reasons:

- · Participant illness or injury that prevents attendance
- · Death or family emergency

NOTE: Work conflicts, changes of mind, family vacation plans, and "better opportunities" will not be accepted as reasons for a refund. You will simply forfeit your spot, UNLESS YOU CAN FIND A SUBSTITUTE. A substitute must be of the same gender as the original participant so that a "swap" is easily made.

PIGGYBACKING

Piggybacking with other congregations <u>WILL</u> be allowed. This means that a participant from Youth Group A (from one congregation) can "tag along"/participate with Youth Group B (from another congregation).

ROOM & BOARD

You will stay in dorms on the Xavier University campus. Rooms will be two-person rooms with air-conditioning and shared floor bath facilities. Genders will be housed in separate rooms and floors-this holds true for youth leaders, families, and married couples alike. Each person will be provided with a linen packet that includes: a pillow, pillowcase, blanket, a flat sheet, a fitted sheet, two bath towels, two wash cloths, soap, and a cup. Meals will be served at the Xavier U cafeteria. Your registration fee covers—Dinner on Monday evening; Breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Tuesday; Breakfast on Wednesday; and Breakfast and Lunch on Thursday. (Lunch and Dinner at the Creation Museum and Ballpark are at your own expense – figure about \$15 per meal).

WHAT HAPPENS AT A RALLY?

A WELS District/Regional Rally is a wonderful opportunity to grow as a child of God and a Christian friend to others. For this rally, up to 200 youth and youth leaders will study God's Word together through inspiring and interactive large group presentations and small group discussion.
