GROUP REGISTRATION

Contact youth leaders must preregister the group by entering the names of each participant in the Group Registration Form. At this time, the contact youth leader will also assign roommates and assign the youth to their youth leaders in a 8 to 1 ratio. This will hold your spots for the rally. Youth leaders will stay with leaders from other churches.

INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION

Following preregistration, each participant and youth leader must register on www.welsyouth.net through the Youth Leader Registration Form or the Participant Registration Form and make his/her payment. In order to secure the early-bird rate, all payment must be received prior to Mar. 16th.

All teens who have completed eighth grade through the 2017 high school graduating class. Yes, we are encouraging first-year college/university students to attend.

If someone is out of high school but not 20 years old, the contact youth leader and pastor should decide if this person should attend as a youth or if he/she can take the responsibility of a youth leader.
